### **Giorgio Mondini**

Giorgio Mondini was born in Reggio Emilia, Italy, on June 22, 1941; he graduated from the State University of Milan in 1965 (J.D. magna cum laude) and was admitted in Italy in 1968. A recipient of a Fulbright Scholarship, he attended the Academy of American and International Law in Dallas, Texas, and was an Assistant Professor of International Law at the State University of Milan.

Later on he specialized in intellectual property, and specifically in copyright law, media law (including new media, the Internet, etc.), patents and trademarks, unfair competition, telecommunications legislation, and in corporate matters. He has represented large Italian and foreign media companies in transactional and contentious work in Italy, including one of the major US multinationals operating in the book, music, film, broadcasting and related industries. He regularly advises some of the major trade associations in the above fields. He also is member of the International Advisory Board of Entertainment and Media Law of the Southwestern University School of Law (Los Angeles, Cal.) and Vice Chairman of the IPR Committee of the American Chamber of Commerce in Milan (Italy). He participated in several legislative projects on copyright and intellectual property matters and took part in various tenders on telecommunications law. Mondini is a frequent international commentator on intellectual property and media issues. He is also the author of several publications on intellectual property. He was a founding member of AGICA (the Cinema and Audiovisual Jurists' Association), which he chaired for several years.
